

Introduction of SEU International Summer School Program

Theme : Cultivation of Globally Competitive Talents in COIL Learning Mode

Overview:

This project provides courses jointly offered by Chinese and Japanese universities with the purpose of co-cultivating globally competitive talents. The project, taking the form of international joint teaching, offers lectures, discussions, cultural instructions and other activities, the topics of which include:

Course 1- Japanese Modern History and Chinese Culture;

Course 2- Communication in the Context of International Education;

Course 3- "Memory of Jiangsu's Cities" Found in Japanese Classics.

On the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the normalization of Sino Japanese diplomatic relations, this summer school course, taking Sino-Japanese communication and cultural comparison as the starting point and giving consideration to international frontier academics, offers in-depth online courses and introduces the new model of mixed teaching to help students sense the social and cultural differences between China and Japan, promote cross-cultural understanding, train cross cultural communication skills from the perspective of internationalization, and enhance the exchange of Chinese and Japanese young students.



Schedule Description: Aug 22 (Monday) ~ Aug 27 (Saturday)

A1- Opening Ceremony: The project leader and related personnel describe the online project and introduce the lecturing professors. Students of Southeast University and Japanese universities give self-introductions.

A2~A5: Special lectures for Chinese and Japanese university students. 4 courses to be offered (1 course a week).

A6: Making presentations to be rated by teachers.

B1~B5: Exchange of views on shared topics.

B6: Summary of students' presentations.

C1~C5: Social practices of Chinese and Japanese university students.

C6: Teachers summarize and confer certificates to international students.
