Course Objective／授業の目的と概要	<p>This course provides students with an introduction to Hindi traditional grammar and technical terms used in it.</p> <p>By the end of this course students will be able to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. gain knowledge about Hindi traditional grammar;</li> <li>2. understand specific technical terms used in Hindi (or Indian) traditional grammar.</li> <li>3. have a viewpoint of comparative/contrastive language studies.</li> </ol> <p>Students who successfully completed the primary and intermediate Hindi courses (or equivalent) will be eligible to attempt this course. In addition, they are expected to have completed a general linguistic course before attempting this course.</p> <p>Week: 1 (Introduction to language and script)  Week: 2-4 (Phonological system and writing system)  Week: 5-8 (Words-1: sangyaa, sarvnaam, visheshan, avyay, kaarak)  Week: 9-10 (Types of sentences: simple, compound, and complex)  Week: 11-14 (Words-2: padkram, arth, kriyaa, vachan, ling)  Week: 15 (Feedback)</p> <p>Note: The schedule may change in accordance with the students' level of comprehension. Classes will be held online later in the semester (8th to 14th).</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pre-class preparation is essential for class participation. Students are expected to read the textbook and to understand the content BEFORE the class.</li> <li>2. Other reference materials for the course may be announced in class as needed.</p> <p>Evaluation (100%) will be based on daily attendance and active participation in discussion (30%) and also on the mid-term and the final exams (70%).  Attendance is essential in this class.</p> <p>NOTE: The final exams can be replaced with several mini exams depending on the situation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If a student has a valid excuse for missing a examination and wants to take a makeup exam, he/she must communicate with the office of academic affairs of the Faculty. Make-up exams will be given only in case of an emergency or unavoidable problems such as personal illness (requires verification).</li> <li>2. Attendance only is not sufficient for earning credit for 30% of the total evaluation. If a student comes to class late without a valid excuse, he/she will be deducted 0.5 percent of his/her grade at the end of the course.</li> </ol> <p>Students who have missed more than 5 lessons will not be graded, even if you take an examination. Students should notify the instructor in advance if they have good and acceptable reasons for a long absence (more than 5 weeks).
