HISTORIC URBAN-RURAL LANDSCAPE OF PINGYAO DESIGN WORKSHOP

Ancient City of Pingyao is a UNESCO World Heritage City, which exemplifies the Ming and Qing towns in northern China. This design workshop is to pursue a balanced development of Pingyao's urban and rural settlements today based on the historic urban-rural spatial structure of ancient Pingyao - its historic town and seven surrounding fortified villages. This workshop is also one of a series of design workshops in cooperation between Southeast University and Norwegian University of Science and Technology.

Tasks:

- (1) Research on City God temple Area in Pingyao Ancient City
 - a. Historical and cultural values of City God Temple;
 - b. Cultural heritage management, community management, heritage;
 - c. Renovation of old houses;
 - d. Preservation of the historic area.
- (2) Overall Protection and Sustainable Development of the fortified villages.
